Rules for

Myotonic Goat Registry Sanctioned Shows on September 10, 11, 2010

1. All goats must be registered by Myotonic Goat Registry. The **original** registration certificate must accompany the goat during check in.
2. Pending registrations at the time of entry will not be accepted.
3. Age eligibility for classes will be determined by birth date on registration certificate.
4. Substitutions will be allowed at check-in within the same class.
5. No percentage goats will be shown.
6. First show will start at 6 PM Friday, September 10, 2010 and the second show will start 9:00 AM on Saturday, September 11, 2010.
7. Goats will be released immediately after show on September 11, 2010, but will be allowed to stay until Sunday the 12th if needed.
8. All goats must wear a collar or restraint when not in pens. Goat owners are responsible for securing their goats at all times
9. Show secretary reserves the right to split larger classes.
10. Scrapie rules apply. All goats must have a health certificate. If you use microchips you must have a reader. All tattoos must be legible. Scrapie tags are acceptable. You must have a extra copy of the health certificate available for the show committee.
11. MGR rules to govern and take precedence over all others.

12. Entries must be received no later than September 6, 2010 to appear in the show book and to guarantee pen reservation. Late entries will be accepted, but pens may not be available.

13. All goats brought into facility must be entered in show. Only exception will be for does and nursing kids.

14. Entry fee is eight dollars per goat, per show, per class. Pen fees are \$10 per pen (bedding included) for the duration of the weekend. No entry fee for Showmanship or non-sanctioned classes.

15. Initial straw bedding is provided. Additional bedding will be available for purchase.

16. Check-in will be from 3:00 to 5:30 pm on Friday, Sept. 10 and 7:00 to 8:30 am on Saturday, Sept 11th for those showing on Sat only. You must be checked in by that time or the animals will not be allowed to show.

17. The organizers of this show will not be responsible for any loss, damages or accidents to animals property or persons while participating in the show. Youth exhibitors must be accompanied by responsible adult.

Statement of liability:

The Show Management will not be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur. Each exhibitor will be solely responsible for their own liabilities, if incurred, as well as damage or injury to any other person or property caused by the exhibitor or animals they exhibit.

Class 4. Senior. Doe Kids: 6 to 8 months of age (Born 1/11/10 - 3/10/10)

Class 5. Advanced Sr. Doe Kid: 8 – 12 months of age (Born 9/11/09 – 1/10/10)

Class 6: Jr. Yearling Doe 12-18 mos (Unfreshened)

Class 7: Sr. Yearling Doe 18-24 mos (Unfreshened)
